

**JURY &
SELECTION PROCESS**

With the Jury Application(s) include:

- Four (4) 3" x 5" or 4" x 6" photographs. (**Please do NOT send more than four photographs or photographs larger than the sizes noted.**)
- Label each photo on the back with artist's name, dimension of the art work, medium, and category to be juried.
- Jury fee of \$25 (non-refundable), postmarked no later than **January 1st, 2010.**
There will be a 2nd jury process for applications postmarked after 1/1/2010. However, those applications require a \$50.00 (non-refundable) fee per category.
- NOTE: Photos submitted for jury consideration will not be returned.

The nature of submissions must be themed Art of the American West and images submitted must be representative of the art that will be displayed if accepted into the show.

Functional art will not be considered by the jury panel. Artists' works are not identified by name during the jury process. Jurying is conducted by a panel of experienced art professionals and is based solely upon the quality of work as illustrated in submitted photographs. Jury decisions are final.

BOOTH INFORMATION

There are approximately 160 booth spaces available. Artists will be allocated a minimum of 10' x 15' space for a booth. Electrical power is available for a limited number of booths (at an additional fee). Artists must provide their own display equipment, lighting, extension cords, etc. Canopies are recommended, but not required. Further information concerning site specifics will be provided with the artist acceptance packet.

If juried into the show, all fees, including the booth fee of \$450, will be due by March 1st, 2010. Do not send fees until notified of acceptance. **Booth spaces are assigned on a first-paid basis.** All revenue from the sale of the artwork will be retained by the artist. Artists are responsible for any sales taxes.

These rules must be complied with during the show and will be provided in the artist acceptance packet sent to you once your artwork has been juried and accepted. The PHIPPEN MUSEUM will promote the Art Show with display advertisements, newspaper articles, radio and television.

ELIGIBILITY

The show is open to all artists submitting work featuring **Art of the American West** in the following seven media categories: Acrylic, Drawing, Mixed Media, Oil, Pastel, Sculpture, and Watercolor. Participation in any previous show does not guarantee acceptance. Awards will be given in each medium category.
